Canadian Rockies by Rail Day by Day Itinerary

Day 1: Welcome to Calgary

Upon arrival in Calgary, a Globe Treks representative will greet you and assist with your transfer to the Hyatt Regency Calgary. Enjoy the evening at leisure to explore downtown Calgary or relax after your travels.

Day 2: Calgary City Tour & Arrival in Banff

After breakfast at the hotel, embark on a guided city tour of Calgary. Visit the Calgary Tower and the 1988 Winter Olympics sites, then head to Banff. A scenic drive through the foothills of the Rockies offers stunning views into the region's natural history. In Banff, take the Sulphur Mountain Gondola to the summit for breathtaking views of six mountain ranges before checking in at Hotel Canoe & Suites for two nights.

Day 3: Discovering Banff & Lake Louise

After breakfast, spend the day discovering Banff National Park's natural wonders. Enjoy a scenic drive through the park, stopping at Bow Falls and picturesque lakes. Enjoy lunch at the Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise. Enjoy stunning views of the lake and Victoria Glacier. Take a stroll around the lake or simply relax with the beauty of the area before returning to Banff. In the evening, enjoy dinner at a local restaurant and a night spent at your leisure.

Day 4: Icefields Parkway Adventure/Jasper Arrival Today, journey along the world-famous Icefields Parkway, one of the most scenic drives in the world. Stop at Bow Lake for some incredible photo opportunities, then continue to Athabasca Falls, where the roaring waters carve through ancient rock. Upon reaching the Columbia Icefields, enjoy a delicious lunch before boarding the Ice Explorer for a thrilling ride across the Athabasca Glacier. Afterward, walk along the Columbia Icefields Skywalk, a glass-floored bridge that extends over the Sunwapta Valley. In the evening, arrive in Jasper and check in at the luxurious Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge, located along the shores of Lac Beauvert, offering the perfect setting to unwind after an adventurous day.

Day 5: Exploring Jasper & Maligne Lake

This morning, embark on a scenic cruise along Maligne Lake, known for its stunning blue waters and Spirit Island. Experience the true beauty of Jasper National Park before enjoying a leisurely lunch. Then spend the afternoon exploring the park's natural wonders at your own pace. In the evening, savor a special dinner at the lodge, while you reflect on the stunning landscapes you've witnessed throughout your journey.

Day 6: Rocky Mountaineer to Quesnel

After breakfast, board the Rocky Mountaineer for the first leg of your rail journey, traveling in GoldLeaf Service. Relax in the glass-dome coach and enjoy panoramic views of Mount Robson, Yellowhead Pass, and Moose Lake. With a second breakfast and lunch onboard, continue through Prince George and follow the Fraser River, arriving in Quesnel. This charming town, the gateway to British Columbia's North Cariboo, offers a restful evening before continuing your adventure.

Day 7: Rocky Mountaineer to Whistler

The journey continues south through the Fraser Canyon, past Deep Creek Bridge and vast ranchlands, with highlights including glacial-fed Seton Lake. Arriving in Pemberton, transfer by motorcoach to Whistler, a world-class resort town. Explore its vibrant village, nestled between towering mountains, before relaxing in the evening, ready for the next day's explorations.

Day 8: Whistler to Vancouver

Enjoy a leisurely morning exploring Whistler Village's charming shops and scenic viewpoints. Afterward, board the Rocky Mountaineer for the breathtaking ride along the Sea to Sky Corridor, passing through Cheakamus Canyon, Mount Garibaldi, and Brandywine Falls.
