

Enjoy the Newport Aquarium, relax on a dinner cruise on the Ohio River, visit Dayton's National Museum of the U.S. Air Force, and explore Cincinnati's Museum Center.

Day 1: The Ark & Enchanting Newport Riverside

After the Ark Encounter, we'll head to the charming riverside town of Newport, KY, where you'll enjoy a delicious dinner at one of its renowned restaurants, offering local flavors and fantastic views of the Ohio River. Spend the next three nights at the newly renovated Fairfield Inn in Newport's historic district, with easy access to Cincinnati's bustling riverfront and its famous skyline.

Day 2: Cincinnati's Timeless Treasures & Delights

Day 3: Aviation Marvels & Cultural Exploration

Today, we journey to Dayton, Ohio, to visit the National Museum of the U.S. Air Force, a must-see for history and aviation enthusiasts. See historic planes from WWII to the Space Age, and discover the technology that shaped flight over the last century. Afterwards, we return to Cincinnati for a visit to the Cincinnati Museum Center, located in a stunning Art Deco train station. Here, you'll experience the Duke Energy Children's Museum, the Cincinnati History Museum, and the Museum of Natural History & Science, each offering interactive exhibits and fascinating displays.

In the evening, we'll gather for dinner at the famous Hofbräuhaus, an authentic Bavarian beer hall that brings the spirit of Germany to Cincinnati. Enjoy a hearty German meal accompanied by live music, creating a festive and lively atmosphere as we celebrate the day's adventures.

Day 4: Unforgettable Farewells & Lasting Memories

On our final day, we head south to Berea, KY, known as the "Folk Arts and Crafts Capital of Kentucky." Berea College, a pioneer in coeducational and interracial education, offers a unique glimpse into Appalachian heritage. For lunch, enjoy a special meal at Boone Tavern, a historic inn known for its Southern hospitality and acclaimed cuisine. The inn's elegant dining room and storied history as part of Berea College's outreach program make this the perfect place to savor a final culinary delight.
